A fee of £395 will be payable when you complete on a mortgage arranged by us. We will also be paid commission by the lender.



A fee of £395 will be payable when you complete on a mortgage arranged by us. We will also be paid commission by the lender. The fee will be reduced by the amount of commission we are paid by the lender. Where the commission from the lender exceeds £395 we will not charge a fee. So in many cases, no fee will be payable.



A fee of 0.5% of the loan will be payable when you complete on a mortgage arranged by us. We will refund any commission that we are paid by a lender. For example, on a mortgage of £200,000, a fee of £1,000 will be payable.

Insurance advising and arranging is covered for 90% of the claim, without any upper limit.

Mortgages

Mortgage advising and arranging is covered up to a maximum of £50,000.
